Digital Library is under progress for which a code will be issued to each student for on-line reading.

### Anti Ragging Committee

Ragging in any form is strictly prohibited as per regulations of Statutory Bodies of Government of India and the directions of Supreme Court. The institute shall strictly observe the provisions of the Act of the Central Government and the state governments, if any, or if enacted, considering ragging as cognizable offence under the law on a par with other atrocities against women and ill-treatment of persons belonging to SC/ST, and prohibiting ragging in all its forms.

Ragging in all its forms is totally banned in the entire institution, including its departments, constituent units, all its premises (academic, residential, sports, canteen etc) whether located within the campus or outside and in all means of transportation of students, whether public or private. The institutions shall take strict action against those found guilty of ragging and/or of abetting ragging and for the same we have constituted Anti-Ragging Committee that will take every possible measure to prevent ragging.

The students and parents have to submit an affidavit prescribed by Government of India to this effect.

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# Library Rules

Library membership is open to all the students of the Rayat Institute of Pharmacy.

- Library will remain open from Mondays to Friday from 9.00 A.M to 4.00 P.M.
- All first year students are required to obtain their Library Tickets/ Identity Cards from the librarian within 15 days of joining the college.
   The same are to be retained by them throughout their tenure in the college.
- Members can borrow books from the library for duration of 14 days and can be re-issued only if they are not in demand.
- An overdue charge of Rs. 5/- per volume per day will be charged for books retained beyond the due date.
- The Librarian may recall any book at any time, if necessity arises.

### Attendance-cum-Absenteeism Rules

75% percentage attendance in both theory and practical classes is mandatory failing which the student shall be disqualified from sitting in the university exams.

Attendance will be marked daily and monthly shortages will be displayed on the notice board and even if it is found less than 75 %, the student may not be able to sit in the mid semester exams. Students availing Rayat-Bahra scholarships will have to clear the examinations otherwise the scholarship would be discontinued.

No student will be allowed to enter the class once the faculty is inside the class.

# Procedure for Leave

Students desirous of availing leave on genuine ground may apply the leave to their respective Class-Incharges and get the same approved by the Director/Principal. If student is unable to attend the classes due to an emergency, he/she should intimate the Class-Incharge telephonically. Medical leave will be sanctioned for maximum of 7 days in a semester after approval from Director/Principal.

### Mid Semester Exams and Internal Assessment

There will be three mid semester exams during the session, of these two are compulsory and average of two will be taken.

Time table for MST shall be displayed on the notice board and announcement shall be made in the class by the Academic coordinator.

The syllabus for MST shall be displayed on the notice board for each subject by the respective teachers.

Anyone who misses the test without prior director's permission won't be allowed another chance.
